POLICY ON THE CONDUCT OF END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR RITES

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned
This Region

1. As indicated in Enclosure No. 1 of DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2016 entitled School Calendar for School Year (SY) 2016-2017, the End of the School Year Rites should be scheduled either on April 6-7, 2017:

Grade/Level	Ceremony	Proof of Completion
Grade 6 learners who will complete Elementary Education	Graduation	Elementary Certificate (Enclosure No. 1)
Grade 10 learners who will complete Junior High School	Moving Up or Completion	Junior High School Certificate (Enclosure No. 2)
Grade 12 learners from: a. Schools with DepEdapproved K to 12 transition plan b. Schools with a permit to operate SHS starting in SY 2014 c. International Schools with K to 12 Program d. Private Schools with Certificate of Recognition as Early Implementers in SHS	Graduation	High School Diploma (Enclosure No. 3)

- 2. In line with the government's austerity program, the Department of Education (DepEd) reiterates the following policies:
 - a. Graduation for Elementary and SHS Early Implementing Schools and the Moving Up Ceremony for Grade 10 should conduct meaningful ceremonies that will encourage sense of community and awareness on social and personal responsibilities. While these rites mark a milestone in the life of the graduates and completers,

these should be conducted without excessive spending, extravagant attire, or extraordinary venue;

- Expenses relative to the activity should be charged to the school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses under the 2017 Budget;
- c. Parent-Teachers Association may give donations in cash or in kind;
- d. Wearing Toga is not allowed;
- e. No Year Book Policy should be observed per Regional Memorandum No. 55, s. 2016;
- f. Any DepEd Personnel should not be allowed to collect any graduation/moving up/closing ceremony fees or any kind of contribution;
- g. Unified Program for the Moving Up and Elementary Graduation Ceremonies is attached in the herein enclosure;
- h. Medals from sponsors, politicians and others other non-curricular should be awarded during the recognition. Awards to be given at Graduation should be strictly academic awards only;
- i. Purchase of commercialized medals is strictly discouraged. Instead, medals made by the SHS should be patronized;
- j. Graduation exercises should showcase capability of SHS; hence decorations and food preparations if any, should serve as laboratory of SHS, and elementary schools should tap the services of nearby SHS.
- 3. Further, the Graduation Rites and Moving Up Ceremony should be conducted in an appropriate solemn ceremony befitting the graduating pupils and students and their parents; and appropriate restraint should be observed to avoid making the occasion into political activity.
- 4. Private schools may have the option to follow or modify the provisions of this policy provided that austerity measures are strictly observed.
- 5. For dissemination and strict compliance.


