UPDATES AND REMINDERS ON THE BASIC EDUCATION LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. To ensure an effective and efficient implementation of the curriculum, schools shall adhere to the changes and strategies in the implementation of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan as stipulated on the issuances from the offices of central, regional and divisional.
- 2. The following updates and reminders are as follows:
 - a. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2021 on the Amendment to DepEd Order No. 030, s. 2020 (Amendment to DepEd Order No. 007, s. 2020, School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021), paragraph 4 of DO No. 030, s. 2020 is amended as follows:
 - 4.2 The schedule for the succeeding quarters shall be adjusted as follows:
 - 4.2.1. Quarter 3 shall be from March 22, 2021 to May 15, 2021
 - 4.2.2 Quarter 4 shall be from May 17, 2021 to July 10, 2021
 - 4.3 The additional two-week period shall be compensated by a similar adjustment in the school break between SY 2020-2021 and SY 2021-2022.
 - b. Regular encoding of grades in the Curriculum Management Support System through http://27.110.168.75/rox-cms/ based on the Regional Memorandum 101, s. 2021 on the Implementation of Curriculum Management System in Light of the Basic Education



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Learning Continuity Plan. The schedule of encoding indicated below shall be strictly observed by the schools:

Quarter 1 - March 17-18

Quarter 2 - April 7-8

Quarter 3 - June 3-4

Quarter 4 - July 28-29

c. Development of standardized performance tasks, written works and weekly home learning matrix shall be formulated for quarter 3 and quarter 4. Performance tasks shall be thematic across learning areas by grade level and shall integrate the following values appropriate to the performance standards and content standards in each quarter.

Quarter 3 (March 22 - May 15)	Quarter 3 (May 17 - July 10)
Integrity	Respect for Life
Accountability	Self Reflection and Analysis
Discipline and Order	Taming of Tongue
Equality	Transparency
Faithfulness	Trust
Justice	Word of Honor
Purity Reliability	Excellence

The list of writers is enclosed in the Division Memorandum No. 209, s. 2020 entitled Writeshop on the Development of Standardized Performance Tasks, Written Works, and Weekly Home Learning Plan Matrix. Outputs for the third quarter and fourth quarter shall be submitted to the learning area education program supervisors for evaluation from March 31 to April 8 and May 24 to June 4 respectively.

d. Distribution of cards shall be strictly done every quarter in accordance to paragraph 27 of **DepEd Order No. 007**, s. 2020 on **School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2020-2021**.

Paragraph 27 stipulates that:

Parent-Teacher Conference (PTC) shall be done not earlier than the Second Saturday after the examinations for the first



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three Academic Quarters. It will be used as a venue to apprise the parents on the performance of their children and ensure their involvement in school activities. The school shall have the responsibility to determine the appropriate manner of undertaking the PTC. For parents without access to online conference, and where face-to-face is allowed, social distancing must be strictly observed. Report cards shall be distributed to parents/guardians, where feasible, otherwise a scanned copy of the Report Card may be uploaded online for access of only the learner and his/her parents or guardian, in consideration of the confidentiality of school records.
