Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) No. 203, s. 1987, declaring the 9th day of April as the *Araw ng Kagitingan* and Presidential Proclamation No. 466, s.1989 declaring April 5-11 as the Philippine Veterans Week, the celebration of the Philippine Veterans Week and the 79th Anniversary of the *Araw ng Kagitingan* will be on April 5-8, 2021 and on April 9, 2021 respectively.

In support of the upcoming commemorations, the Department of Education (DepEd) through its External Partnerships Service (EPS) and in cooperation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), shall conduct Virtual Symposium, Creative Painting and Oratorical Contest. The Department of National Defense (DND), Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP), Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) and DepEd shall collaboratively organize and sponsor these activities. Details of these significant events and competitions, including the contest mechanics are provided in the attached Enclosures 1 and 1a, 2 and 2a respectively.

Consistent with the guidelines and protocols issued by the Inter Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID), Department of Health (DOH), and DepEd due to the COVID-19 pandemic, abovementioned symposium on *Araw ng Kagitingan* and Philippine Veterans Week shall be conducted virtually on **April 8**, **2021**. Said symposium will be hosted by DepEd Region III, Schools Division Office (SDO) of Bataan and Balanga.

All regional directors (RDs), schools division superintendents (SDSs), district supervisors, and schools heads are enjoined to actively participate in the virtual activities relative to these celebrations.

79TH ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK

CONTEST MECHANICS CREATIVE PAINTING CONTEST

1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 79th Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) and the Department of National Defense (DND) are sponsoring a Creative Painting Contest.

The Contest objectives are to increase awareness of historical places in the Philippines during World War II where veterans fought for the country and sacrificed lives, and to remember the reasons why we experience freedom up to this day.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 4, 5 and 6 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

3. Scope / Theme

The entries should depict the life, works and heroism of our Filipino heroes who fought for our country and should be in line with this year's theme: "KAGITINGAN AY GAWING GABAY, PANDEMYA AY MAPAGTATAGUMPAYAN."

4. Entry Specification

Only entries submitted in correct and complete specifications and formats will be considered official. Please take note of the following requirements to ensure that the entry satisfies the specifications of the contest:

- 4.1 The painting should be in a 15"x 20" illustration board.
- 4.2 Contestants may use any medium of their choice.
- 4.3 The painting must be described in one or two sentences. The description must be typewritten and printed on a ½ A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the entry together with the following information:
 - 4.3.1 Name of Learner
 - 4.3.2 Contact Number
 - 4.3.3 Address of Learner
 - 4.3.4 Name of school
 - 4.3.5 School Address
 - 4.3.5 Division
 - 4.3.6 Region

4.4 The Philippine Flag should not be used as background of the painting. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the artwork (please refer to Sec. 39 – Prohibited Acts under Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 titled "An Act Prescribing the Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines.").

5. Criteria

6. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The entry which will get the highest score shall be declared as the National Champion, the entry with second highest score shall be declared as the first runner- up, and the entry with third highest shall be declared as the second runner-up, so on and so forth.

Virtual awarding of winners for the Poster-Making Contest will be held on May 7, 2021.

7. Submission of Entries

- 7.2 Each entry must be accompanied by the following requirements:

CONTEST MECHANICS ORATORICAL CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

2. Theme and Content

The **oratorical piece must be in Filipino**, **original**, never been published, and expounding on the theme: "**KAGITINGAN AY GAWING GABAY**, **PANDEMYA AY MAPAGTATAGUMPAYAN**."

The piece must be delivered for a minimum of seven (7) minutes and a maximum of 10 minutes.

The oration **MUST NOT**, in whole or in part, expressly or impliedly offend any race, religious freedom, nor should it be against the laws of environment, honor and dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.
