MUSIC VIDEO COMPETITION

 The Music Video Contest is open for all Grades 7 to 12 learners enrolled during the SY 2020-2021 in any public and private schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

The Regional and Schools Divisions MAPEH Supervisors (RSDMSs), are designated as heads of the Regional Quincentennial Committee (RQC/SDQC), Regional Supervisor Araling Panlipunan (RSAP) will be the member of the National Quincentennial Committee to oversee the identification, selection of entries in their respective areas.

Each region shall submit five (5) entries only. Champions from the previous competitions conducted by the External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU) are discouraged to join the competition to give chance to others.

- 2. The entry should have a minimum of 10 and maximum of 15 participants including the conductor. Members may come from different public and private schools but should be within the area of their jurisdiction.
- 3. The contest piece will be "Bagant" a song written and composed by Roel Rostata and interpreted by Pinopela. The video should not have an introduction nor credits. The video must be limited to 5 minutes. For additional details relative to the contest piece, kindly visit the following:

- 4. The performances will be pre-recorded. No participant must be compelled to shoot the performance outside his/her home. Use of original, localized video clips, or pictures in editing contest entry is allowed.
- 5. While practicing and making their music video entries, participants are reminded to follow local IATF protocols and observe minimum health standards like wearing of facemasks/shields, practicing regular washing of hands, using of alcohol and sanitizers, observing social distancing, among others.

Criteria for Judging

6.1 Performance (25%)

- 6.1.1 the visual images demonstrate excellent relevance to the music and/or lyrics, or tell a story that follows the music.
- 6.1.2 lip synching/singing takes place throughout appropriate increment during the video and is performed in a professional manner that demonstrates comprehension of the lyrics.

6.2 Concept and Development (25%)

- 6.2.1 exceptional plot/idea development (story) must logically and be sensibly focused on the new normal situation of the country.
- 6.2.2 interest is developed and sustained at a high level.

6.3 Visual Interpretation/Creativity (25%)

- 6.3.1 outstanding skill in showing imagination and creativity in content and production techniques.
- 6.3.2 superior attempt in creating a product that shows originality.
- 6.3.3 outstanding and imaginative skill in showing mood, style and

6.4 Technical (25%)

- 6.4.1 lighting is creatively and effectively used.
- 6.4.2 audio is flawless and well balanced using ambient sound, music and/or sound effects effectively.
- 6.4.3 camera work is outstanding using shots and angles to provide
- 6.4.4 editing is effectively used to enhanced message.
- 6.4.5 graphics/titles are used to enhance the topic or message.

7. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The contestant who will get the highest score shall be declared as the National Champion, the contestant with the second highest score shall be declared as the first runner-up, and the contestant with the third highest score shall be declared as 2nd runner-up, so on and so forth.

The names of the winners and process on claiming their prizes shall be announced in a separate memo.
