


- 1. In the continuous pursuit of excellence in providing quality professional development programs for teachers and school leaders, this Office directs all personnel from the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) and Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) to conduct Monitoring and Technical Assistance Provision to their assigned school/s for the 2024 Midyear In-Service Training (INSET) on January 24-26.
- 2. Schools-based INSET shall focus on the teachers' learning and development needs and on sharing information on the following policies and priority programs:
  - a. Training for Teachers Teaching Non-Major Subjects (e.g., Filipino, MAPEH, etc.);
  - b. Microsoft 365 Productivity OnlineTraining through DepEd Philippines;
  - c. National Learning Camp;
  - d. National Reading Program;
  - e. National Mathematics Program;
  - f. Catch-up Fridays;
  - g. Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN);
  - h. Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the Comprehensive Sexuality Education (DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2018);
  - i. Child Rights Policy: Adopting the Rights-Based Education Framework in Philippine Basic Education (DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2022);
  - j. DepEd Child Protection Policy (DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012); and
  - k. Safe Spaces Act (Republic Act No. 11313).
