

SUSPENSION OF FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES DUE TO HIGH HEAT INDEX

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Teachers, Parents
All Others Concerned

This Division

- 1. The field is hereby advised that in the event of high Heat Index beyond 40, whole day Face-to-Face classes are suspended and shall automatically switch to distance learning delivery modes (modular, online or offline). Teachers should be ready at all times with their lessons, modules and activity sheets for distribution every Monday or on any day of the week.
- 2. When distance learning delivery is adopted, teachers must still report to school to prepare their lessons and IMs. Learners' outputs should be submitted and checked daily or depending upon the discretion of the teacher.
- 3. It is reiterated that suspension of Face-to-Face classes shall be done in extreme heat condition only. Heads of schools should write SDO for Approval when condition is posing health-risk to the learners.
- 4. Heads of schools should be alert on any issuances from LGU, PAG-ASA, C/PDDRM or from DepEd Division Office.
