# Recycled/Indigenous Christmas Tree Making Contest 2024

### GUIDELINES:

This competition is open to all public and private schools within El Salvador City.

### Tree Shape and Design

The entry must be designed in the shape of a traditional Christmas tree.

### Size Requirements

- The tree must have a maximum diameter of 3 feet and a height of 7 feet (excluding the star).
- The star at the top of the tree should be no taller than 2 feet, bringing the total height of the tree (with star) to 9 feet.

### **Decoration and Materials**

- The tree must be handmade. Commercially made tree are not permitted.
- All decorations must be crafted from recyclable or indigenous materials.

### Lights

 The tree must include lights to enhance the display. However, candles and live fire are not permissible.

### Display Location and Date

The completed tree must be displayed at Tuburan Spring on or before December 1, 2024.

#### **Additional Notes**

- All trees must be sturdy and safe for display.
- Entries must be designed for easy transport and setup at the event location.
- Only teachers, learners and other staff are permitted to design the said parol, so each participating school is advised to refrain from hiring a designer. Hiring a designer from outside will result in automatic disqualification.

### CRITERIA:

# Creativity and Originality (30 points)

Judges will evaluate the unique and imaginative aspects of the tree design. Points will be awarded for original ideas, innovative concepts, and the overall creative expression displayed in the creation of the tree.

# Workmanship and Durability (20 points)

This criterion focuses on the quality of craftsmanship and the overall durability of the tree. Attention to detail, precision in construction, and the ability of the tree to endure various conditions will be considered.

# Use of Recycled Materials (30 points)

Sustainability is key in this category. Participants will be assessed based on the extent to which recycled and indigenous materials are incorporated into the tree. Judges will look for resourcefulness and eco-friendly practices in the selection and use of materials.

### Aesthetic Appeal (20 points)

The Judges will look for the visual impact, overall beauty, color coordination, balance, and symmetry of decorations and attractiveness of the tree from all viewing angles.
