MIDYEAR SCHOOL BREAK ACTIVITIES FOR SY 2024-2025

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisor, SGOD & CID Education Program Supervisor, TLE All Public Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. Regarding DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2024 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities For The School Year 2024-2025, this Office directs all public elementary and secondary schools to conduct the annual five-day **Midyear School Break for SY 2024-2025** on **November 25-29**.
- 2. The five-day midyear school break shall encompass a blend of professional development and assessment of programs, projects, and activities (PPAs). A three (3)-day School-Based In-Service Training (INSET) shall be conducted on November 25-27 and the remaining two (2) days November 28-29 shall be dedicated to the Midyear Performance Review and Evaluation.
- 3. Moreover, compliance with the encoding of grades in the Curriculum Management and Supervision System shall follow the provisions stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 483, s. 2021 (Guidelines on the Utilization of Curriculum Management and Supervision System Templates). The data shall be used to quantitatively analyze the learners' performance and the effectiveness of the programs, projects, and activities to improve learning outcomes.
- 4. The schedule of submission of the quarterly grades is one week after the quarterly examination. The field is reminded of the submission of accomplished templates to the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent through the Curriculum Implementation Division. The deadline for the submission shall be on or before **December 14.**
- 5. Attached are the templates for reference.
- 6. This Office shall adhere to the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, or political affiliation.


