1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), announces the **Orientation on Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Program for School Heads and Teachers in School Serving IP Learners** on November 20 at San Francisco de Asis Elementary School, Barangay San Francisco de Asis, El Salvador City.

2. The activity aims to

- a. identify the importance of contextualizing lessons in the actual teaching-learning process,
- b. deepen understanding of the concepts of Indigenous Peoples Knowledge Systems and Practices (IKSPs), Indigenous Learning System (ILS), Culture Bearers, Holders, FPIC, and community Protocols,
- c. develop ideas from the team to ensure proper coordination on the conduct of the proposed activities and programs to be undertaken,
- d. articulate the fundamental principles and MATATAG curriculum standards that link to IPEd,
- e. discuss issues and concerns related to the implementation of the IPEd program, and
- f. integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights, in the provision and governance of basic education.

3. The participants in this activity are the select school heads and coordinators (Attachment 1).

4. Meals and snacks of the participants shall be charged against the Division IPEd Project Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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
