- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) in coordination with DepEd El Salvador City Division will administer the National Achievement Test for Grade 6 for SY 2024-2025, pursuant to DepEd Order (DO) No. 55, s. 2016, titled "Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program" on April 8, 2025.
- 2. The **NATG6** is an exit assessment that is designed to determine if Grade 6 learners are meeting the learning standards in the Elementary curriculum. The test design measures **five** learning areas (English, Mathematics, Science, Filipino, and Araling Panlipunan) in a multiple-choice format.
- 3. In selecting the Room Examiners the following requirements must be met:
  - a. at least an Elementary Teacher I to Master Teacher from the SDO;
  - b. must **NOT** be the teachers of the participating test takers;
  - c. preferably, must have experienced administering any national/international assessment;
  - d. must be physically fit to perform tasks such as moving test materials, checking for cheating, and monitoring the testing room; and
