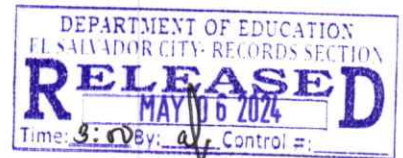

In consonance with **DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012** entitled **Guidelines on Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide**, the field is hereby informed of the activity of BSP Mis Or Council *Boy Scouts of the Philippines Advance Training Course for Leaders of Adults, Outfit Advisors, Troop and Kawan Leaders*.
2. The Advance Training Course (Woodbadge Course) Leaders of adults will be hosted by the BSP Misamis Oriental Council on May 24-30, 2025.
3. The standard fee for the training course is Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00). The fee will be charged by meals, training materials, kits, certificates, and other operational and administrative expenses.

This activity encompasses the desire to strengthen advance quality school based scouting program that gives young people the opportunity to develop their skills and acquire competencies necessary to survive in an increasingly complex and challenging world, underlying the necessity for discipline and good order, illustrate the technique of "learning by doing" by the immediate application of newly acquired scouting skills, and give as many scouts possible experience of leadership.

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the Advance Training Course (Woodbadge Course) Leaders of Adults on May 24-30, 2025 to be hosted by the BSP-Misamis Oriental Council;
2. Qualifications for Participation are as follows:
 - a. Must be a registered District Scout Commissioner/Institutional Head/Circle Managers/LCEB/Unit Leader/Outfit Advisor;
 - b. Must have attended Basic Training Course;
 - c. Physically fit as certified by a physician;
 - d. Have good leadership potentials;
 - e. Have camping gears and equipment; and,
 - f. Have attended the Pre-Training Orientation conducted by the Council
3. A standard Training fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) will be collected each participant to cover cost of their meals, training materials, kits, certificates and other operational and administrative expenses.
4. In the activities of this nature, participants must bring the following:
 - a. Approved Application Form;
 - b. Current BSP Membership Card;
 - c. 2 pcs. 1X1 ID Picture in Type-A Uniform;
 - d. Complete Type-A Uniform:
 - **Male** (Type-A Polo, Adult Neckerchief with Carabao Slide, Short, Socks, Garter Tab, and Black shoes with Shoelace);
 - **Female** (Type-A Polo, Adult Neckerchief with Carabao Slide, Skirt, Socks, and Garter Tab, and Black shoes with Shoelace).
 - e. Filipiniana costume/Barong;
 - f. Camping Gears (Tent, sleeping mat/bag, eating utensils, personal first aid kit and toiletries);
 - g. Extra clothes (casual/working clothes enough to last for the duration of the training.
