#### WEARING OF ASEAN OR FILIPINIANA ATTIRE EVERY MONDAY STARTING JUNE 2025

- 1. Pursuant to **DepEd Memorandum No. 028, s. 2025** titled Guidelines on the New Department of Education National Uniform for Teaching, Teaching-Related, and Non-Teaching Personnel, and in consonance with **Civil Service Commission (CSC) Memorandum Circular No. 16, s. 2024** on the Revised Dress Code for Government Officials and Employees, this Office informs all personnel of the adoption of **ASEAN and Filipiniana attire every Monday** effective **June 30, 2025**.
- 2. All classroom-based and office-based personnel are encouraged to wear ASEAN- or Filipiniana-inspired attire every Monday, as part of the weekly uniform schedule established under DepEd Memorandum No. 028, s. 2025. This attire promotes cultural identity, pride in heritage, and professionalism in line with national and ASEAN values.
- Since School Year 2025–2026 is considered a **transition period**, Personnel
  may still wear their existing uniforms during this time. Full implementation
  of the new uniform schedule, including Monday's ASEAN/Filipiniana attire,
  begins in **SY 2026–2027.**
- 4. Exemptions from wearing the prescribed uniform may be granted for reasons such as pregnancy, mourning, emergency situations, or other analogous circumstances. Requests for exemption must be submitted in writing to the Head of Office at least 15 days in advance. All submitted requests for exemptions are subject to approval. Non-wearing of the Filipiniana/Asean inspired attire on Mondays without prior approved exemption shall be marked absent.
- 5. All are enjoined to **disseminate this memorandum widely** and ensure that the intent of both DepEd and CSC directives is understood and respectfully implemented in their respective schools and offices.
