- 1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, which upholds the need for a learner-centered, inclusive, and developmentally appropriate curriculum, and in line with the Department of Education's thrust to improve reading literacy among learners, and anchored on DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2018 titled "Implementing Guidelines on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI)", which mandates all schools to conduct reading assessments to improve instruction and learning outcomes in reading, this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) Orientation for Reading Teachers on July 25, 2025 (Friday), from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Hotel Monicon, Poblacion, El Salvador City.
- 2. The orientation aims to:
 - a. deepen the understanding of reading teachers on the implementation and administration of the revised Phil-IRI;
 - b. familiarize participants with the tools, guidelines, and reporting procedures of Phil-IRI; and
 - c. strengthen reading assessment practices to support data-driven instruction and intervention.
- 3. Participants to this activity are designated Reading/English Coordinators or Reading Teachers from elementary and secondary schools. School Heads are advised to ensure the attendance of the identified teachers and to make necessary arrangements to avoid disruption of classes. Please see **Enclosure A** for the complete list of participants and **Enclosure B** for the flow of the program.
- 4. Meals and training materials will be provided. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds or School MOOE, or other available funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
