ALS ELEVATE: A SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON BUILDING BETTER PORTFOLIOS,
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS, AND PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES

1. This seminar workshop is designed to enhance the competencies of ALS implementers in developing learner portfolios, instructional materials, and professional practices. It supports the continuous improvement of teaching strategies and assessment tools aligned with the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum and PPST and to foster collaboration and innovation among ALS Teachers in delivering inclusive and quality education.
2. In this regard, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct a Seminar Workshop entitled: **“ALS Elevate: Building Better Portfolios, Instructional Materials, and Professional Practices”** on August 29-30, at the Conference Room, Diamond Building, DepEd El Salvador City, Zone 3, Poblacion, El Salvador City.
3. The activity aims to
 - a. demonstrate competencies and ensure effective educational delivery;
 - b. deepen understanding on Academic-Focused Bridging Program (AFBP);
 - c. equip with the necessary knowledge and skills on instructional materials and portfolio development to facilitate easier learning and concept;
 - d. address gaps in PPST for Teachers’ COI and NCOI; and
 - e. integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination, and human rights, in the provision and governance of basic education.
