Patriotism and Nationalism

c. Community Service and Environmental Projects such as Tree Planting, Mangrove Reforestation, Waste Segregation and Recycling, Canals and Water Ways Declogging, Coastal Clean Up Activities.

All participants must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines to be covered by its 24/7 Group Insurance in case of eventualities.

Reports on the activities conducted by the schools and districts, with proper documentations, shall be submitted to the Council and Division Office not later than October 30, 2025.

Participation and involvement to the activities conducted will qualify the Unit Leaders/Outfit Advisors for the BSP Service and Merit Awards for Unit Leaders as provided in DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012. It will also support Scouts in their advancement to the next higher rank and pre-qualify them to earn the WOSM Better World Programmes – the Messengers of Peace (MOP) Initiatives; Tide Turner Plastic Challenge; Scouts Go Green Program; World Scout Environment Programs (WSEP); and the Scouts of the World Award (SWA).

As such, we respectfully request that Woodbadge Holders and Scout Leaders who will attend the activities scheduled on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays be granted service credits in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers."
