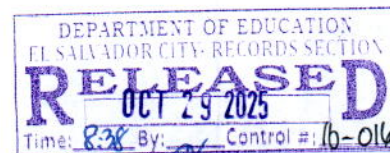

AMENDED BY-LAWS OF THE PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I – NAME

Section 1 – The name of the organization shall be **PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, INC.**, hereinafter referred to as the **"PPSTA"**.

ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVES

Section 1 – The objective of the PPSTA shall be to promote the interest and welfare of the Philippine public school systems and of public education personnel. Specifically, the PPSTA shall seek:

- To provide the course of education as an agency for Filipino nationalism and promote the principles of the **ASEAN Council of Teachers + 1 (ACT+1)** and Education International (EI). *(as amended on October 16, 2020)*
- To protect and help its members.
- To keep its members in close touch with one another.
- To operate and maintain a mutual aid and benefit systems and related financial institutions which shall provide financial assistance **to members and their designated beneficiaries or dependents.** *(as amended on October 16, 2020)*

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 – The following may become members of the PPSTA:

- All teaching and non-teaching personnel of public schools in the Philippines;**
- Personnel of the PPSTA and its local chapters;**
- Retirees, resignees or transferees previously belonging to a) or b) above; and**
- Independent trustees during the duration of their term of office. *(as amended on October 16, 2020)*

Section 2 – There shall be three (3) classes of members, namely:

- Regular members – all members who belong to any of those listed in Section 1 and who have applied and been accepted as members of the PPSTA;
- Life Members – regular members who paid the duly approved life membership fee; and
- Honorary Members – persons who do not belong to those listed in Section 1 but have played important roles in the promotion and preservation of the welfare of the PPSTA and whose
