

## RESTRICTION ON DIVISION OFFICE VISITS BY SCHOOL HEADS AND TEACHERS

This Division

- 1. In line with the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program (ARAL) and to ensure that there will be no disruption of classes, all school heads and teachers are restricted to visit the Division Office during class hours. School heads and teachers shall only be accommodated after 4:00 pm.
- 2. Moreover, school heads are directed to intensively monitor and observe teachers to ensure proper and quality delivery of teaching.
- 3. Submission of official documents to this Office, concerns relative to MOOE, and the like, shall be handled by the Administrative Officer II, Administrative Assistant III and II, and the school designated liaison officer.
- 4. The division office security personnel and watchmen will be instructed to prohibit you to enter the Division Office if without valid reasons.
- 5. This Division Memorandum adheres with the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in observing all policies and protocol of the said activity. Hence, all actions shall be based solely on guidelines set with no discrimination on the account of age, gender identity sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, or political affiliation.
