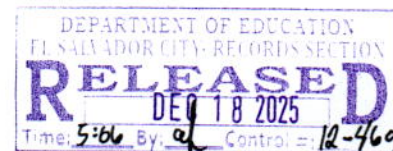

ORIENTATION ON UTILIZING PRIMER 3 TEACHING AND LEARNING  
RESOURCES AND STRENGTHENING EARLY LANGUAGE  
LITERACY AND NUMERACY

1. In support of DepEd's commitment to strengthen early literacy and numeracy, the Schools Division of El Salvador City will conduct an **Orientation on the Utilization of Bridging Primer 3 Teaching and Learning Resources and Strengthen Early Language Literacy and Numeracy** on December 22, 2025, at the Division Conference Room, DepEd Building, Poblacion, El Salvador City.
2. This activity aims
  - a. to enhance teachers' capability to effectively use Primer 3 in facilitating a smooth transition from Mother Tongue to Filipino or English literacy, and
  - b. to introduce the primer's structure, instructional sequence, and learner-centered strategies aligned with DepEd standards for early grade instruction.
3. The participants in the orientation are Elementary School Heads and School ELLN Coordinators.
