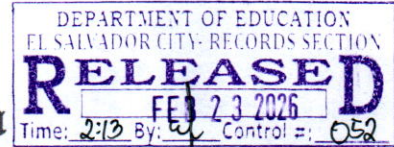

DIVISION ORIENTATION ON THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS)
 CURRICULUM

To: Division Chief, Curriculum Implementation Division
 Education Program Supervisors
 Public and Private Senior High School Heads
 Teachers

1. This Office thru the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct a **Division Orientation on the Strengthened Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum** on February 26 at Conference room, 2nd Floor Diamond Building, Poblacion, El Salvador City.
2. The activity aims to
 - a. present the key features of the strengthened curriculum,
 - b. capacitate senior high school heads and coordinators on subject offerings across tracks and strands, and
 - c. share challenges and best practices from the pilot implementer.
3. The participants are the education program supervisors, senior high school heads and coordinators, and teachers teaching strengthened SHS curriculum.
4. The participants' travel expenses shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
5. Participation shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*. The concerned school head is advised to assign teachers to handle the classes of the identified teacher-participant.
6. This Office adheres to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity or political affiliation.
