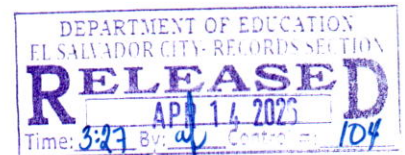

TRAINING ON THE REVISED GRADES 6, 9, AND 10 CURRICULUM

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 289, s. 2026 regarding DepEd Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-082, this Office announces the participation of identified personnel in the Training on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum scheduled on various dates within the National Capital Region (NCR).
2. The activity aims to orient Core and Regional Trainers on the enhancements of the curriculum to ensure effective implementation and delivery at the field level. All nominated participants for the training of Regional Trainers are listed in Enclosure No. 1.
3. Identified participants are required to register and submit the following documents through the link tinyurl.com/g6910registration.
 - a. Duly signed Terms of Reference (TOR) for Trainers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum; and
 - b. PRC-templated Curriculum Vitae.
4. Participants shall arrange their travel in accordance with the schedules specified in the training matrix. Attendance for the entire duration of the training is required; substitution or replacement of participants, as well as late arrivals or early departures, are strictly not permitted.
5. The participants' board and lodging, transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the FY 2026 Human Resource Development (HRD) Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. This Office shall adhere to the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, or political affiliation.
