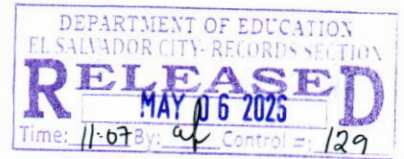

MONITORING OF THE ARAL PROGRAM 2026 IMPLEMENTATION AND OTHER SUMMER PROGRAMS

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. In line with the implementation of the ARAL Program 2026 and other Summer Programs for School Year 2025–2026, this Office announces the conduct of monitoring activities to ensure effective and efficient program implementation in all public schools from **May 06, 2026 to June 2, 2026**.
2. The monitoring aims to
 - a. ensure compliance with existing policies, standards, and guidelines,
 - b. assess the delivery of learning interventions in Reading and Mathematics,
 - c. provide timely technical assistance to school implementers, and
 - d. gather data and best practices to inform policy enhancement and program improvement.
3. The Education Program Supervisors (EPSs), in their capacity as Technical Assistance Providers (TAPs), are hereby directed to monitor the implementation of the ARAL Program and other Summer Programs. They shall ensure that all activities are carried out in accordance with existing DepEd policies, guidelines, and standards. Specifically, they are to
 - a. conduct regular school visits and/or remote monitoring,
 - b. validate program implementation, including learner participation, session delivery, and resource utilization,
 - c. provide on-site and/or virtual technical assistance to teachers and school heads,
 - d. document observations, issues, and best practices, and
 - e. submit consolidated monitoring reports to this Office.
