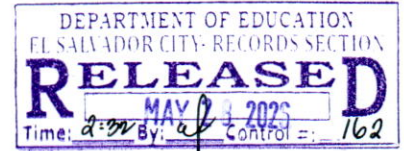



1. The Department of Education (DepEd) is committed to protecting and promoting the health and well-being of learners. Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) and Mental Health are interrelated determinants of learner development, school participation, and academic outcomes. The Regional Office (RO), through the Education Support Services Division - Health and Nutrition Section (ESSD-HNS), will conduct the **Unified Training on Implementation of Adolescent Reproductive Health and Cascade of Katatagan Plus: A Community-Based Mental Health Program with Children and Adolescents Risk Screener for School Mental Health Program** at Cagayan de Oro City, from April 27 to May 1.

2. Katatagan Plus: A Community-Based Mental Health Program, and ARH interventions are complementary. Integrating both programs into a unified capacity-building initiative for division focal persons and schools ensures coordinated, sustainable, and contextualized school and community and school responses. Thus, this activity aims to

- a. To strengthen the mental health promotion, prevention, and early identification mechanisms in schools through the effective cascading and implementation of Katatagan Plus and to identify learners who may be at risk for emotional, behavioral, or psychosocial concerns through the Children and Adolescents Risk Screener.
- b. To strengthen school-based prevention and response mechanisms on teenage pregnancy, and HIV-AIDS through capacity-building on adolescent reproductive health program with establishment of trained Peer Health Navigators in schools.
- c. Promote the integration of Reproductive Health Education (RHE) in the curriculum.


