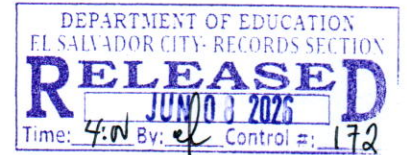

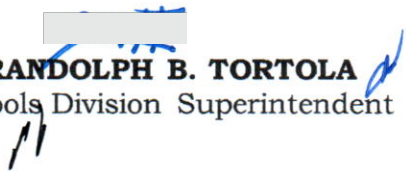
DIVISION TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON THE REVISED
GRADES 6, 9, AND 10 CURRICULUM

1. Pursuant to the strategic rollout of the enhanced curriculum guidelines and following the completion of the regional-level training, this Office announces the conduct of the **Division Training of Teachers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum** on June 18–20, 2026. The pre-work activity is scheduled for June 10, 2026.

5. Travel and other related expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Further, this Memorandum shall serve as the Official **Authority to Travel** for the participants.
6. This Office shall adhere to the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Roles	Responsibilities
Chairperson	- Serves as the overall director and ultimate authority of the training rollout. - Approves the training proposal, budget allocation, funding sources, and the official division memorandum. - Provides high-level policy direction and strategic oversight to ensure alignment with national and regional standards. - Signs certificates of participation and recognition for the participants, resource speakers, and management team.
Vice-Chairperson	- Acts as the chief operating officer of the rollout, managing the execution of the training program. - Oversees the functional performance of all working committees and monitors the daily progression of the training. - Assists the Chairperson in strategic decision-making and stands in as the officer-in-charge in the absence of the Schools Division Superintendent. - Reviews deliverables and programmatic adjustments before final approval by the Chairperson.
Team Leaders	- Provide thematic and divisional direction to the training implementation, bridging curriculum adjustments with technical operations. CID Chief: Manages the academic and technical integrity of the training, supervising the Education Program Supervisors (EPS) and resource speakers. SGOD Chief: Supervises logistics, resource mobilization, health safety protocols, and overall venue/hall management. - Directly report progress, bottlenecks, and overall evaluation metrics to the Vice-Chairperson.
Assistant Team Leaders	- Supports the Team Leaders in administrative operations and coordinates workflow across the different learning areas. - Assists in consolidating program outputs, attendance metrics, and daily management logs. - Ensures that instructions from the Team Leaders are effectively cascaded down to the Technical Working Groups (TWGs). - Acts as the primary troubleshooter for administrative issues arising during the actual training dates.

TWG Lead	• Meets and manages the Class Managers, while actively overseeing the daily training progression across all designated classrooms; • Oversees all prework activities and coordinates room preparations • Gathers, organizes, and distributes the final slide decks and presentation materials to the Class Managers before each session; • Prepares the official daily attendance sheets and ensures that the entire training program strictly adheres to the requirements for CPD (Continuing Professional Development) accreditation; and • Controls the overall scheduling flow, ensuring sessions open, transition, and close precisely on time.
TWG Support	• Handles the manual and immediate logistical tasks required to keep the training rooms operational. • Distributes and collects learning materials, registration sheets, and meal allowances/kits. • Assists in setting up physical tables, group banners, and dynamic room configurations. • Manages the physical or digital indexing of daily outputs submitted by each group.
Monitoring and Evaluation Officers	• Ensure the quality, standards, and operational effectiveness of the training rollout through continuous data gathering and feedback. • Develop and deploy online evaluation tools (such as daily evaluation links and end-of-program assessment forms). • Observe training sessions objectively to check if the session objectives, time allocations, and delivery methods align with the approved training design. • Consolidate, analyze, and interpret participant feedback and daily attendance data. • Provide daily QAME debriefing reports to the Team Leaders and Vice-Chairperson, highlighting areas of success and recommendations for immediate corrective action.
Medical Responders	• Ensure the physical health, safety, and medical welfare of all participants and management staff throughout the training duration. • Establish a designated first-aid and medical station within the venue • Conduct immediate medical triage, monitor blood pressure, and manage common ailments

	• Maintain a log of health-related concerns and coordinate emergency transportation to the nearest medical facility if critical care is required.
Resource Speakers	• Serve as the subject matter experts responsible for the direct delivery and cascading of the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum content. • Prepare comprehensive presentation decks, instructional materials, and hands-on workshop activities aligned with the assigned curriculum competencies. • Deliver sessions engagingly, keeping track of the allotted time while allowing space for questions and professional discourse. • Provide expert guidance, critique, and feedback during workshop sessions when participants are developing their daily outputs. • Collaborate with the Class Managers to ensure classroom activities, icebreakers, and evaluations transition smoothly into the academic sessions.
Class Managers	• Handle the Management of Learning (MOL), including daily opening routines and icebreakers; • Monitor and check daily attendance and participant tracking sheets; • Collect and track the submission of participants' required outputs per session; • Assist the resource speakers with classroom logistics and participant coordination; and • Provide real-time feedback and updates to the TWG Lead regarding classroom progress.
Participants	• Attend and actively engage in all breakout sessions punctually; • Develop and submit all required daily deliverables and workshop outputs on time; • Collaborate productively with group members during team tasks and peer-learning activities; and • Complete all daily monitoring and evaluation forms to provide feedback on session delivery.
