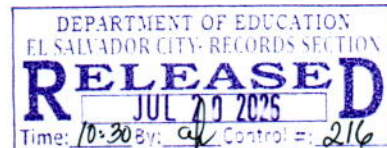

THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SSHS) CURRICULUM

1. Following OM-LS-2026-247 titled **Clarifications on the Time Allotment, Class Programming, and Learning Resources for the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS)**, DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2026, titled **Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education**, and DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2026, titled **Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum** this Office directs all schools to submit class program and teachers program for SY 2026-2027.

- a. While schools have the flexibility to decide on the scheduling of subjects in the SSHS curriculum, there is a need to meet the required number of hours per subject (e.g., 160 hours for Core Subjects, 80 hours or 160 hours per Academic Elective, 320 hours per Tech-Pro Elective). To meet the prescribed instructional hour requirements, schools may adopt suitable FLPS, ensuring adherence to applicable policies and standards.
 - b. Private schools may offer institutional subjects and set the hours for each, provided that these are on top of the required instructional hours for Core Subjects and Electives. However, the total weekly hours, including institutional subjects, must not exceed 40 hours.
 - c. Teachers' workload shall continue to be governed by the existing DepEd policies, including Republic Act (RA) No. 4670 or the "Magna Carta for Public School Teachers". All school heads are encouraged to protect the six (6) hours of actual classroom teaching load per day for all teachers. Asynchronous sessions must be reflected both in the class program and teachers' schedules as part of their teaching load.
3. Learning resources for the implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum, including Lesson Exemplars (LEs) and Learning Activity Sheets (LASs) curated by the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) and the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR), may be accessed through: <https://tinyurl.com/SSHSLEandLAS>. Other learning resources shall be continuously uploaded through the official DepEd website: <https://www.deped.gov.ph/strengthened-shs-program/>. Furthermore, the Resources for Learning Futures (RLF) developed by DepEd Region X may be accessed through: <https://lessonhub.deped10.com>.
4. Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) are directed to closely monitor schools' compliance with the prescribed subject offerings and time allotments under the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum.
5. This Office adheres to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity or political affiliation.

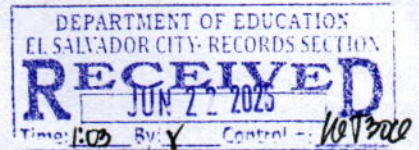

In response to feedback and questions gathered directly from schools during the Opening Block, the following guidelines are issued to support the effective implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum under DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2026.

1. Time Allotment and Class Programming

Time allotments and sample class programs in DO No. 17, s. 2026 may be adjusted to fit each school's context and operational needs, provided the prescribed minimum total instructional hours per subject are met within the Instructional Blocks:

- Core Subjects – 160 hours per subject across 3 Terms
- Academic Electives – 80 hours or 160 hours per subject for 1 Term
- Grade 11 Tech-Pro Electives – 320 hours per subject across 3 Terms
- Grade 12 Tech-Pro Electives – 320 hours per subject for 1 Term

Only teaching and learning hours within the Instructional Blocks count toward the total. The Opening Block and End-of-Term Block shall not be considered part of the total instructional hours, unless used for makeup classes.

To complete the required number of hours without compromising learner welfare, schools may conduct blended learning activities as needed, regardless of the number of shifts, provided that class hours shall not exceed 40 hours per week. Schools that are implementing the 2016 K to 12 Senior High School Curriculum are likewise encouraged to explore blended learning activities. Sample class programs are in Annex D.2 of DO No. 17, s. 2026; additional samples are in **Annex A** of this document.

Teacher workload shall continue to be governed by existing DepEd policies, including Republic Act (RA) No. 4670 or the "Magna Carta for Public School Teachers". All school heads are encouraged to protect the six (6) hours of actual classroom teaching load per day for all teachers. Asynchronous sessions must be reflected in both the class program and teachers' schedules as part of their teaching load.

2. Learning Resources

The DepEd Central Office, through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) and Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR), has prepared a curated set of Lesson Exemplars (LE) and Learning Activity Sheets (LAS) aligned with the SSHS Curriculum. These Learning Resources may be accessed through <https://tinyurl.com/SSHSLEandLAS> and shall also be made available via the official DepEd website.

Please note that the folder entitled **"(Previously Released LRs for SSHS Pilot) Core Subjects and Select Tech-Pro Electives"** is provided for reference and interim use only. Once the finalized resources are made available, the use of the updated versions is strongly recommended.

All learning resources shall be continuously uploaded to the said link and the official SSHS website (<https://www.deped.gov.ph/strengthened-shs-program/>) as they become available.
