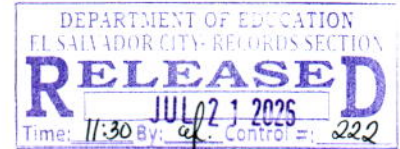

PARTICIPATION IN THE TIKTOK GALING: A DIGITAL SAFETY AND MEDIA LITERACY WORKSHOP

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-284 from the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, this Office announces the pilot implementation of the **#TikTok Galing: A Digital Safety and Media Literacy Workshop** on July 25, 2026, at Mallberry Suites Business Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City.

2. The workshop is designed to equip educators with critical skills for navigating today's complex media landscape. By combining media literacy education with cyber safety training, the program aims to address the spread of disinformation and the rise of cyberbullying. Through interactive modules, hands-on activities, and expert-led discussions, participants will learn to critically evaluate online content, responsibly engage in digital spaces, and foster safer online communities.

3. The Division of El Salvador City is allocated seven (7) slots for Senior High School (SHS) teacher-participants handling Media and Information Literacy, Social Science, and Communication subjects. In alignment with this allocation, the following teachers are hereby designated to participate:

4. The meals for the participants during the workshop shall be provided by TikTok Philippines. Transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged

against local/school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. All participants are requested to bring their own laptops and other necessary learning materials to fully engage in the workshop activities, hands-on exercises, and collaborative sessions.

6. Participants shall be entitled to earn vacation service credits in accordance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 013, s. 2024 (*Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers*), or pursuant to DO No. 009, s. 2025 (*Amendment to DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2024 Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2024–2025*).

7. This Office shall adhere to the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) in the steps undertaken for this purpose. Hence, all decisions and actions shall be based on guidelines set forth, with no discrimination on the account of age, gender, identity, sexual orientation, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, or political affiliation.
