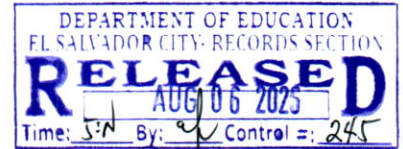

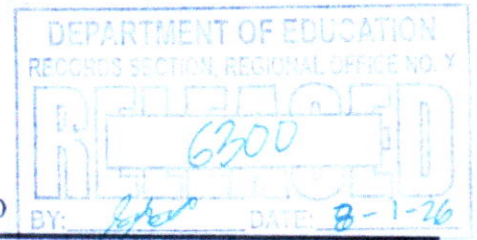

1. The Department of Education Region 10 remains steadfast in its commitment to strengthening evidence-based planning, monitoring, evaluation, and continuous organizational improvement. The Program Implementation Review (PIR) serves as a vital management mechanism for assessing the efficiency and effectiveness of various programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) implemented across different governance level of the organization. To ensure consistency, reliability, objectivity, and comparability of assessment results across governance levels, a standardized data-gathering instrument is imperative. Relative to this, the Regional Office 10 hereby implement the Regional Learner Framework – Rapid Assessment of Program Implementation and Development (RLF-RAPID) system.
2. This aims to achieve the following specific objectives:
 - a. Institutionalize the use of the RLF-RAPID tool as the standard instrument for gathering data in all levels of governance within Region X for the Program Implementation Review; and
 - b. Standardize data collection procedures to ensure uniformity and accuracy;
3. To ensure smooth execution, the respective governance levels shall assume the following responsibilities:
 - a. Regional Office (RO)

Office of the Regional Director – Information and Communications Technology Unit : Shall create and lead in the orientation of the system for the Program Implementation Review and provide targeted technical assistance to lower governance level.

Quality Assurance Division: Shall spearhead the overall management of the RLF-RAPID results.

Policy, Planning & Research Division (PPRD), and **Field Technical Assistance Division (FTAD)**: Shall support in the implementation of the system.
